

# Practice Education Guidelines for BC Usage of Library Resources & Services GL#2-11

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## Practice Guideline

February 28, 2007

Students and faculty have use of the Receiving Agency library during their placement.

## Guideline Details

Students and faculty should wear or present approved identification.

Students and faculty should have access to library services and resources.

The Receiving Agency may restrict the use of and/or borrowing of library materials. The Receiving Agency may restrict hours of access.

## Rationale

The Receiving Agency library is an excellent resource for student research on conditions, client care and assignments. The Placing Agency is the primary provider of library services to its students and faculty however.

Resources and materials are not easily retrieved if the borrower is not a Receiving Agency employee or physician. Receiving Agencies may license use of electronic library products for staff only.
