## Accessing Practice Education Guidelines (PEG)


### Summary:

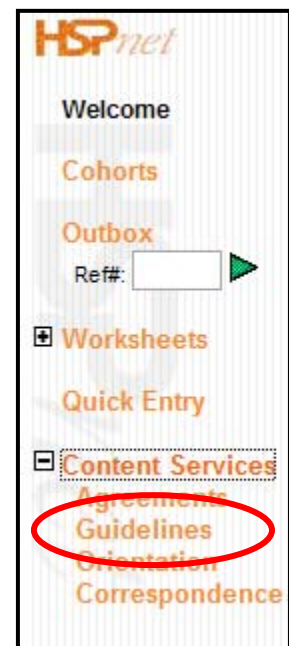
This document guides users on viewing and printing Practice Education Guidelines in HSPnet.

### Background

The PEG module encompasses a set of tools to publish and share “best practice” guidelines or approved policies for a jurisdiction using HSPnet. Guidelines may be published for sharing on a province-wide basis, and may be adopted by an agency as is or modified to meet requirements of a region, site, or program. In the absence of, or complementary to published guidelines, any site or program may publish or upload existing policies for access by other HSPnet users.

### Viewing and Printing Guidelines

1. Login to HSPnet and select **Content Services** from the left navigation, then click **Guidelines**.
2. If a Guideline template exists for a given topic, the icon will have a red checkmark 
3. Click the icon to view the online template
4. Each online Template has 2 levels:
  - [Status and Reviews](#) – content author(s), review/approval status
  - [Content](#) – **select this level** to view the content
5. Click **Print Content** to generate a link to a PDF copy of the guideline for local printing or sharing as an email attachment.
